

# COVID-19 Reopening Plan

Mosaic NextGen Ministry's mission is to be there for the children and families of Mosaic church, while respecting and adhering to all CDC/government recommendations and guidelines concerning COVID-19. The following phases are how we as a church plan on strategically reopening the NextGen ministries to accommodate our children and families.

## Phased Opening Dates:

**August 16-** Open Nursery and 2's class

**August 30-** Open 3's, Pre-K, Kinder

**September 6-** Start Bigs (1st-6th grade)

By opening each of our children's areas in phases it helps ensure a safe, secure environment for our kids and volunteers.

## Phase 3

As parents, you may decide whether or not you want to have your child wear a mask. Social distancing will be helped by staff. If you choose to have your child not participate in their normal class an activity packet for service will be available.

- **All staff and volunteers will be required to wear masks.** -

1. Please do not send your kids if they are having **ANY** of these symptoms:

**Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus.  
People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:**

- Fever or chills

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

2. Temperatures will be checked before entering back to the children's area. If a parent has to walk a little one back their temperature will be taken too. **If as a parent you have a fever your child will not be able to attend.**

*\*According to the CDC recommendations any temperature above 100.4 will be considered a fever.*

3. We will have hand sanitizing stations throughout children's ministry. Kids will be able to keep those hands clean!

4. All large group times will temporarily be suspended and will take place in each individual classroom, to help with social distancing.

5. **NO snacks** will be provided during this phase to help reduce the transmission of germs.

*There will be increased disinfecting and cleaning procedures for all classrooms, toys, and bedding.*

## Phase 4

**All staff and volunteers will be encouraged to wear masks.**
